A quick reminder that there will be no Recharge club this Friday and it will resume in Autumn term on a Tuesday afternoon.

Entrance/collection points for September:

We plan to stick to the same entry/collection points for the next academic year:

- Nursery – Red Nursery door off the yard
- Reception – Reception outdoor area fence
- Year 1/2: Front entrance/Collection at hall doors at rear of school building
- Years 3-6: Front entrance

The doors will be open at 8.40am and closed at 8.50am, with register at 8.55am. Children in Reception to Year 6 should be collected at 3.20pm. All children in Early Years and Key-Stage 1 should be dropped-off and collected by a known adult. Key-Stage 2 children are allowed to walk to and from school by themselves.

Please can we request that you do not park on the school car park or at the bottom of the school drive when dropping off and collecting children. There have been a few instances recently where the bottom of the school drive has been very busy with cars, children walking up the drive and the minibus needing to pull out from the school drive. Keeping our children safe is our number one priority. Blue badge holders are able to park in the disabled bay at the front of the school building.
