We are looking forward to this week's Easter celebrations happening on Thursday 26th March. We are inviting our Nursery & Reception pupils to take part in our annual design an Easter bonnet competition – this is optional, but always a popular event. At the end of the day, we will hold an assembly where our Early Years pupils will parade in our hall wearing their bonnets. Children in Year 1 – Year 6 can decorate an egg and choose from any theme (this again is optional).
