The KABS disco times have now been confirmed as:

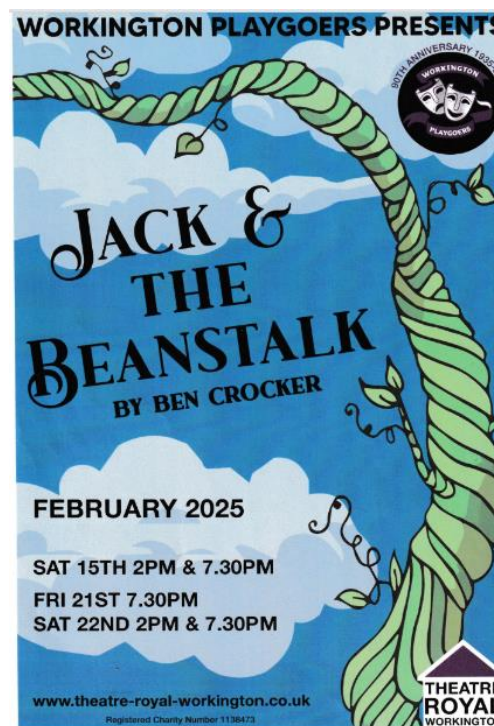
- 5-6pm for Early Years & Key-Stage 1 children (children should be supervised by an adult)
