Dear Parents/Carers,

England World Cup support:

England have made it through to the next round of the World Cup and will play their next game on Wednesday so children can attend school dressed in football kits or red/white clothing if they wish. Children in Year 6, who are attending the Cockermouth School intake days, will need to attend in their usual school uniform.

Sports Day plans:

It is one of our favourite events of the year this Thursday...Sports Day! Please can all children attend school in their PE kits, wearing an item of clothing that shows their team colour (coloured caps or hair ribbons would be fine). If you are not sure which colour team your child is in, please send a message to your child’s class teacher and they will confirm.



Our Early Years sports day will start at just after 9am and so please feel free to go and find a seat by the sports day track at the bottom of the field, after dropping your child off at school. The afternoon sports day for children in Year 1- Year 6 will begin at 1.15pm. The gate will be opened at 1.10pm.

KABS Summer fun day and summer fair:

It is a busy week with fun events this week... On Friday, KABS will be providing their usual summer fun day for our children. All classes will have the opportunity throughout the school day to access some inflatables which will be at the bottom of our school field – the children love this!
