PASTORAL CARE

Focussing on the whole child



Brownedge has a strong tradition of going the extra mile to make sure our children are well-cared for and included. Staff pride themselves in really knowing pupils in their care. The school house system means that older pupils have opportunities to mentor younger ones and help build the family values that permeate school. Our care starts even before pupils come here in our programme of taster and transition days. As a result, children settle quickly into the life of school.





A diverse and relevant CURRICULUM

The Mission Statement of Brownedge St Mary's expresses our intention to ensure that your child is given the opportunity to fulfil their potential using their unique talents gifted to them by God. We are committed to providing opportunities that will allow them to develop as independent, confident and successful learners with high aspirations who enjoy learning and make good progress.

Through our Mission, we develop pupils' personal and moral values based on our Catholic ethos, teaching them respect for other cultures, religions and ways of life (including British Values) and ensuring that all know how to make a constructive contribution to the local, national and worldwide community.

Our curriculum intent is to be responsive to our local context and the profile of our cohort entry. Building on knowledge of your child's prior learning, we ensure that from day one they will be challenged through new and engaging learning, which matches their needs and aspirations. We ensure that our broad and balanced curriculum, delivered by specialist staff, equips them to transition into appropriate progression routes so that they lead successful and fulfilling lives.

We plan and sequence learning such that your child makes good progress. Challenging concepts will be revisited enough times to make sustained gains in new knowledge. We equip them with the technical and subject-specific vocabulary to precisely articulate their learning, orally and in extended writing. They will be engaged in an ambitious curriculum pathway, whether it be one that is traditional (EBacc), technical or vocational.

Our curriculum promotes resilience and determination as key qualities for success, it also demonstrates challenge and ambition, develops a healthy mindset and equips pupils for life and all its diversity.

OUTSTANDING ENRICHMENT

Enhancing learning beyond the classroom

We know from experience that learning does not stop in the classroom and some of the most significant learning moments happen on residential trips and out of school activities. Outside the classroom we provide a diverse experienced curriculum, rich in opportunities to develop knowledge and skills, including collaborative learning, leadership, problem solving, enterprise, work-related learning, acts of service and specialised interests.

The breadth of what we offer our children in the area is enviable. Over recent years, children have benefited from taking part in musical productions, public speaking, maths and computing challenges, national and county level sports, theatre and university trips, residential retreats and trips, including America, Iceland, Italy, France, Battlefields and Wimbledon, and visits to the school from internationally acclaimed authors and actors.

DEVELOP AND CHALLENGE

Of the gifted and talented

Every child matters at Brownedge and we expect our most able, gifted and talented pupils to really fly.

We ensure this happens through a careful programme which includes high challenge in learning, active leadership and enrichment. As a result, our brightest pupils do extremely well.



WORKING IN PARTNERSHIP

With pupils and parents

We work hard to ensure that the school responds to the needs, aspirations and concerns of the members of our school community. There are many opportunities where pupils are able to contribute their views. This can be through Learning Forums, School Council, or discussion's with tutors. Pupils regularly assess their own progress and have a chance to express their view. Parents know that we strive to make ourselves available to discuss their worries at the earliest possible time. We also go further and seek parents' views through surveys, such as those at the end of parents' evenings. 96% of our parents say their children enjoy school and are making good progress.

SUPPORT

Guidance for the world of work and further study play an important part of Brownedge through our careers programme. In Learning for Life, pupils have the chance to reflect on their own aims, their role as citizens and their place in the world. Individual interviews with special advisors, industry days and work experience provide the challenge to enable pupils to succeed. Most pupils successfully navigate school without needing extra support, but some need a helping hand now and again. If you feel your child needs extra help, for whatever reason, please share your concerns with our Special Needs Co-ordinator.

We have a wide range of flexible support available, and can assess pupils for academic, emotional and behavioural support. We believe that all pupils are equally important and we strive to ensure that each one receives a broad and balanced curriculum appropriate to their needs. We welcome pupils with special needs into our school community and recognise the talents they have to offer. OFSTED (2020) noted: "Staff help all pupils to access the curriculum equally. Most parents and carers of pupils with special educational needs and/or disabilities (SEND) are full of praise for the school. They say their children receive excellent support from staff. They achieve well."
