GCSE exams have started and our Year 11 pupils have put a huge amount of effort into their revision and preparation. Mary Day - Friday 24th May

As mentioned in my previous Newsletter, the Year 7 to 10 pupils will participate in a day of House-based sessions on Mary, our patron saint. The theme of the day will be 'The Holy Family' where pupils will look at Mary, Joseph and Jesus as a family and how we can be like a family because of them. The day will be fun-filled and give pupils an opportunity to work and learn together, participate in team building activities and tasks developed to enable them to explore their own spiritual journey. Pupils will finish school at 2pm; should this time be an issue or if any pupil has difficulty in getting home at that time, please inform school and we can make arrangements for them to stay in school until the end of the normal school day.

Whole School Exams - commencing 13th June for Year 10 and 17th June for Years 7, 8 and 9

Summer examinations will take place beginning on 13th June for Year 10 and 17th June for Years 7,8 and 9 and will finish on 19th June. Summer exams are a test of how much pupils know and understand from the work they have done all year. It is vital that pupils learn to revise well. To support pupils and to support you in helping your child prepare for these exams, a revision booklet for each year group has been produced. A copy of the booklet has been emailed home and a paper copy has also been given to the pupils. This booklet includes topic lists for all subjects, the exam week timetable and tips and strategies for effective revision. In preparation for this, all regular written homework will cease after half term to allow your child to consolidate their learning through revision.

Rewards and Prize Night

Heads of House are currently planning the Rewards Day for the end of the summer term to ensure that pupils are rewarded for their hard work. Heads of Faculty and Subject Teachers are also deciding who will receive prizes at our annual Prize Night. This event will be held in Church on Thursday 27th June and will celebrate those pupils who have shown resilience, determination and commitment. There will be more about this in my next Newsletter.

Prefects and School Leadership
