The Memory Cage is inspired by true events, including the 1940s Dunkirk evacuations, and fighting in the Balkans. It looks at conscientious objection in the Second World War, and the trauma suffered by children caught up in conflict.

The Messenger Bird is about modern day treachery set in the top secret Second World War codebreaking site, Bletchley Park. With a trail of secret clues to solve, and time running out fast, it's the story of one boy's frantic bid to save his dad.
