Dear Parents / Carers,

Annual Reports and Transition Meetings.

This academic year reports will be sent to parents/carers via class dojo. Reports will follow the guidelines set out by the Department for Education (DfE) and will be based on your child's performance over the academic year and will take into consideration periods of time your child may have been accessing remote learning due to C-19 related reasons. Your child's report will be sent to you on Friday 9th July 2021. If you would prefer to receive your child's report in a different format, including a hard copy contact the School Office or your child's class teacher who will be able to organise this for you.

Information reports will include:

- An overview of your child's general progress.
- Achievements and assessments based on your child's performance and taking into account periods your child may have been absent from school due to C-19 related reasons.
- Effort and attitude towards each area of the curriculum based on your child's performance and taking into account periods your child may have been absent from school due to C-19 related reasons.
- Your child's new class teacher.
- Phonics screening results for pupils in Y2. The pass mark is 32.
- Teacher assessments for pupils in Y2 and Y6, which are reported to the Trust and the LA.

Information reports will not include:

- Attendance data for the 2020 / 2021 academic year.
- Phonics screening results for pupils in Y1
- Early Learning Goals for pupils in Early Years. These will be provided as a separate document.

Upon receipt of your child's report if you would like to discuss it with your child's class teacher, you can do so by sending a message via class dojo or you can contact the school directly to make a telephone appointment on 01482 328661.

Attendance

Attendance will be based on the summer term only as this is when it was mandatory for all children to be in school. If your child's attendance is below 93% for the period 12th April – 16th July you will receive a separate letter week commencing 19th July informing you. If your child's attendance is below 90% they are considered to be persistent absentees and they will be monitored very closely at the beginning of the next academic year.

Transition

Transition day for pupils in FS2 to Y5 will be held on Friday 16th July in the morning. This will provide your child with an opportunity to meet their new class teacher.

Transition for pupils in Y6 will be held virtually and will take place week commencing 12th July 2021 and secondary schools will provide a series of activities.
