Fees, Voluntary Contributions & Free School Meals

Whilst we do have some outstanding fees owed by parents and carers, as a school we appreciate that Christmas can be an expensive time for everyone and that some of our families may be experiencing additional hardship this year due to the impact of the pandemic, furlough and job losses.

If you are currently unable to pay please do not worry over the Christmas period, we are happy to discuss or accept a payment when we return in January.

For those parents & carers who have larger debts all we ask is that each time you receive a letter please try and pay something off the balance- this could be small weekly amounts or larger amounts each time you're able to do so. ParentPay letters are sent home with pupils every Tuesday to help parents and carers keep on top of fees for school meals and other payment items.

If your circumstances have changed and you think your child may be entitled to free school meals, please contact the school office or send an email to <u>admin@buckingham.hull.sch.uk</u> and we will check our system. Sometimes the system doesn't pick up a change in circumstances and when this happens parents and carers are able to provide evidence of benefits etc for the school to verify and confirm eligibility in order to manually update the system.
