 Weekly Maths Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day) <u>Shape, Space and Measure – Positional Language</u> Create a hopscotch outside to move <u>forwards</u> and <u>backwards</u> When playing with cars or small world objects encourage children to talk about movement (in front, behind, on top, underneath, next to, forwards, backwards, left, right) Pretend to be a robot and write a create a simple set of instructions to move around (3 steps forward, turn left, 4 steps forward) Using a scarf blind fold a family member and give them instructions to move forwards and backwards 	 Weekly Reading Tasks (Aim to do 1 per day) Your child should share a book every day. This can be reading a book aloud every day or sharing a book with an adult. Sing, share and learn the nursery rhyme Humpty Dumpty Create picture cards to sequence the nursery rhyme Create your own silly rhyme about Humpty Dumpty Listen to Little Red Riding Hood on YouTube https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0 W86K1jBJFI Enjoy a Cbeebies bedtime story before you go to bed

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FS Understanding the World Project Week 1

Will it sink or will it float?

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What you will need:

- Container
- Bath
- Water
- Different materials (paper, cardboard, plastic, metal, wood etc)

Talk to the children about each of the different objects and encourage them to talk about the material each object is made from.

Work together to fill the container or the bath and make predictions "What will happen if we put the plastic in the bath? Do you think it will float or sink? How do you know?"

Take it in turns to place the objects into the water and observe what happens. You can repeat the activity using every day/ household objects.

The children could take photographs or draw a picture to record their scientific investigations.
