Important Updates

End of Term – Change of date

The last day of the summer term will now be Thursday 16th July and NOT Friday 17th July. This is to ensure that preparation required to re-open the school in September to all year groups can go ahead in line with DfE guidance. During the summer holidays there will be a deep clean of the entire school building. The expectation is that schools will re-open to ALL children from September.

Breakfast Club and After School Club

I am waiting on further guidance from the Trust and from the DfE before a final decision is taken about opening Breakfast Club and After School Club next academic year. If we can open it would be for a very limited number of pupils and would have to be booked in advance. Priority will be given to children of key workers. Once I have received further information, I will inform everyone.

Transition Meetings

Transition meetings will be going ahead w/c 13th July for children who are not at present attending school in FS2, Y1, Y2, Y3, Y4 and Y5. Miss Doy, Mrs West and Miss Warvill will be contacting families next week to offer their child a time to come into school to meet with a member of staff.
