# Updated Information for whole school return on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2020

We are looking forward to welcoming everyone in Y1 – Y6 back on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> September. Children in FS2 will start w/c 14<sup>th</sup> September and FS1 will start w/c 21<sup>st</sup> September. # Reducing the amount of congestion outside the school gates

# Update on Breakfast Club and After-School Provision

# **Breakfast Club**

Breakfast Club will be open to a **limited number of children from w/c 14<sup>th</sup> September** and **places must be pre-booked in advance.** Breakfast Club will start at 8am and children are to be dropped off and enter by the Main School entrance. Children will be greeted by a member of staff and will be split into Key Stage groups to minimise contact.

# **After School Provision**

After-School Provision will be open to a **limited number of children from w/c 14<sup>th</sup> September**. **Places MUST be pre-booked in advance**. After School Provision will finish at 5pm to allow for cleaning at the end of the day. Priority will be given to parents who go out to work in the first instance. Children will be split into Key Stage groups to minimise contact. Parents / carers to collect their child from the Community Room entrance on Buckingham Street.

Please mail either the school office (admin@buckingham.hull.sch.uk) or Miss Hillman directly (principal@buckingham.hull.sch.uk) if you would like to book a place for your child for Breakfast Club or After School Provision. Thank you to parents/ carers who have already contacted the school. The School Office will be in contact with you next week with details.

#### School uniform and PE kit

All children **MUST** wear their school uniform including black footwear. Please note that the ruling on NO hair dye and appropriate haircuts applies.

P.E. will take place each week and your child's class teacher will inform you of your child's PE day. We ask that you child arrives into school wearing the correct PE kit. Our large sports hall and playgrounds will enable us to ensure activities are spaced. Equipment used will be washed and sanitised and we will not be practicing any contact sports until further notice.

#### Water Bottles

Children to bring a labelled water bottle which can be filled up throughout the day – NO juice or fizzy drinks. Children will take their water bottle home to be washed every day.

#### Face masks

Children in Primary education are not required to wear a mask. We will be ensuring handwashing takes place several times a day. Classrooms are set up to ensure all safety measures are in place to keep children and staff safe.

# Lunch times

Children will remain in their class 'bubbles' across lunchtime. Children who stay packed lunch will keep their packed lunch with them. Children who are free school meals or choose to order a school dinner will have a hot or a cold option. Children in Y4, Y5 and Y6 will eat in the Dining Hall and Y3, Y2, Y1 and FS will eat in their classroom. This will be reviewed at October half term. This is to ensure that we maintain social distancing, children remain in their class 'bubbles' and lunchtimes take place in a timely manner.

# Communicating with your child's class teacher

Your child's class teacher will communicate to you via class dojo. Please ensure that you have signed up if you have not done so already.

The School Office will continue to send out important information via Teachers2Parents text messaging service.

If your contact details have changed during the summer holidays, please inform the School Office as soon as possible, to ensure you receive up-to-date information.

Our priority is to ensure the safety of children and staff when everyone returns to school from next week. Please note that the above information is still subject to change depending on Government guidance and I will send out information if there are any changes. Your cooperation is appreciated.
