#### **School Uniform**

A gentle reminder to all families about school uniform. It is important that children who are attending school are wearing the correct school uniform including school shoes and correct PE kit. Children who are learning from home should be dressed and ready for learning, ideally sat at a table or desk to reduce the number of distractions. Teachers will be contacting parents if their child is not wearing the correct uniform in school.

Nearly every child in the school has completed at least one FRED reading card and we have some children who are now on their **BLUE** FRED reader.

Children in Y5 and Y6 have exceeded all expectations and have between them read over **6.500.000 words** since September!! We encourage every child during half term to keep reading.

Teachers have been looking at different ways to keep all children both in school and at home connected together as a class. There have been some fantastic ideas, which include class quizzes, finding out about pets at home to imaginative PE sessions using lots of creative thinking. ## Online Safety Week - w/c 8th February



Online Safety Week has raised awareness amongst children in school and at home of what to look out for to remain safe online. The theme this year has been about trust and not to believe everything you read or see. If you are unsure, tell an adult who can help.

#### Important Information - REMINDER

If your child has been in school and develops symptoms within 48 hours of school closing on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2021 AND they test positive you must inform the school via the School Nursing Team. #### Fees, Voluntary Contributions & Free School Meals

Whilst we do have some outstanding fees owed by parents and carers, as a school we appreciate that some of our families may be experiencing additional hardship this year due to the impact of the pandemic, furlough and job losses.

If you are currently unable to pay please do not worry, we are happy to discuss or accept a payment when you are able to do so.

For those parents & carers who have larger debts all we ask is that each time you receive a text reminder or a letter please try and pay something off the balance- this could be small weekly amounts or larger amounts each time you're able to do so.

Weekly reminder texts are sent to parents and carers of all pupils who have an outstanding balance on their ParentPay account and we hope that this will help parents and carers keep on top of fees for school meals and other payment items.

If your circumstances have changed and you think your child may be entitled to free school meals, please contact the school office or send an email to <a href="mailto:admin@buckingham.hull.sch.uk">admin@buckingham.hull.sch.uk</a> and we will check our system. Sometimes the system doesn't pick up a change in circumstances and when this happens parents and carers are able to provide evidence of benefits etc for the school to verify and confirm eligibility in order to manually update the system.
