# Fees, Voluntary Contributions & Free School Meals

Whilst we do have some outstanding fees owed by parents and carers, as a school we appreciate that some of our families may be experiencing additional hardship this year due to the impact of the pandemic, furlough, and job losses.

If you are currently unable to pay please do not worry, we are happy to discuss or accept a payment when you are able to do so but please do ensure that you contact the school office or Miss Hillman to notify us of your circumstances.

For those parents & carers who have larger debts all we ask is that each time you receive a text reminder or a letter please try and pay something off the balance- this could be small weekly amounts or larger amounts each time you're able to do so. Again, please ensure that you contact the school office or Miss Hillman to update us on your circumstances.

Weekly reminder texts are sent to parents and carers of all pupils who have an outstanding balance on their ParentPay account, and we hope that this will help parents and carers keep on top of fees for school meals and other payment items.

If your circumstances have changed and you think your child may be entitled to free school meals, please contact the school office or send an email to <a href="mailto:admin@buckingham.hull.sch.uk">admin@buckingham.hull.sch.uk</a> and we will check our system. Sometimes the system doesn't pick up a change in circumstances and when this happens parents and carers are able to provide evidence of benefits etc for the school to verify and confirm eligibility in order to manually update the system.
