## Review Day - Wednesday 4th September 2019

I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for the Review Day at the start of the new school year on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> September. Our Review Day process allows tutors to have individual time with their tutees to discuss their progress over the past year and set targets for the new school year. This will involve some personal reflection using a prompt sheet and then a one to one review between the tutor and your son/daughter. The arrangements are as follows:

- Students are not required to wear uniform if they are coming in for a review
- Failure to attend the appointment will result in an unauthorised absence being issued

Please note that there will be NO PROVISION to supervise students for only part of the day, students will either attend school for their review appointment only or will attend school for the whole day. Students for whom there is no prior arrangement should not come in until their appointment time and will return home afterwards.

The full timetable will commence for all students on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> September from 8.45am. This will include periods 1 and 2 in tutor groups, with their normal timetable beginning after break.
