Physical Education Kit Information

Physical education (PE) is a vital part of the curriculum at key stages 3 and 4. In order for students to develop into happy, healthy adults, it is important that they develop their physical competence and confidence and their ability to use these to perform in a range of activities.

To fully participate and experience the benefits of PE and school sport, it is important that students are prepared appropriately to do so. This includes wearing the appropriate school PE kit, and being aware of the requirements of any recommended or mandatory personal protective equipment (PPE). Wearing PPE will not guarantee protection from injury. It can though, in many cases, mitigate the severity of injury by reducing a high-risk situation to one of reasonable or acceptable risk. All boys in Key Stage three and four will take part in a football unit and will therefore be required to bring football boots and shin pads.

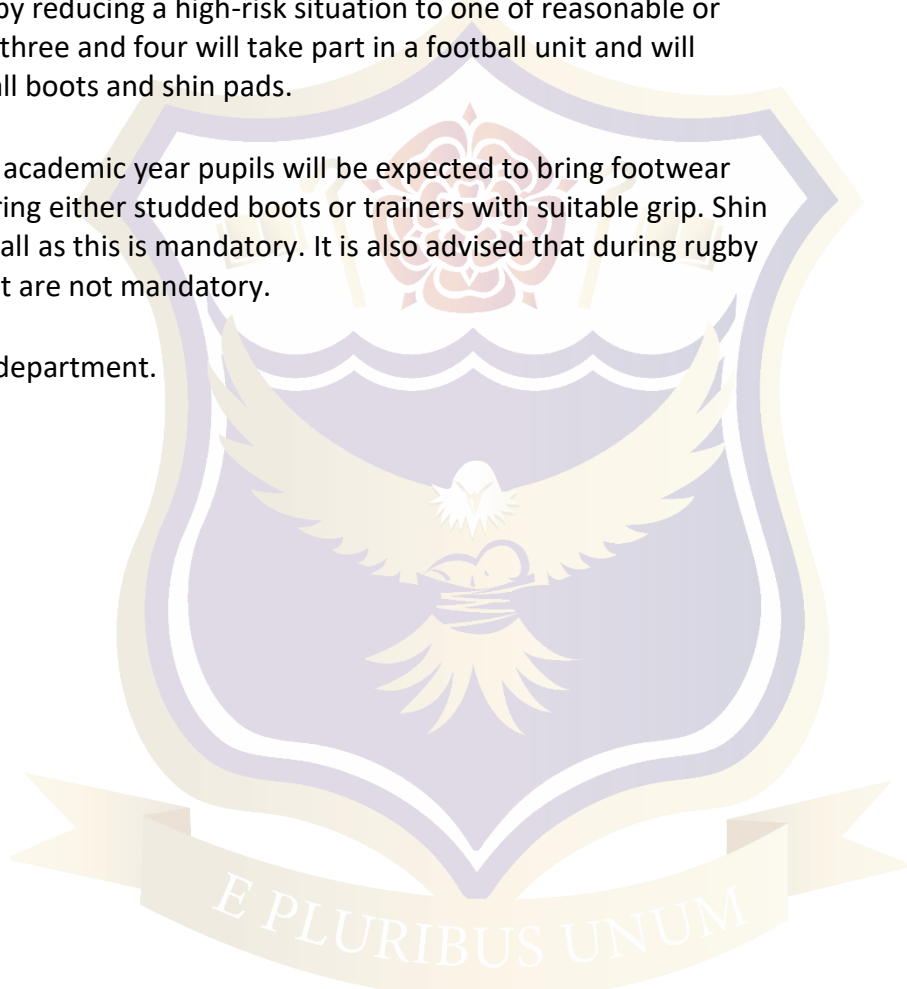
Please be aware that throughout the academic year pupils will be expected to bring footwear suitable for the field. Pupils should bring either studded boots or trainers with suitable grip. Shin pads must also be worn during Football as this is mandatory. It is also advised that during rugby units, gum shields should be worn but are not mandatory.
