Year 10 - 6th Form Taster Day @ Ormskirk School - Tuesday 13th July 2021

Ormskirk School 6th Form College are delighted to be offering your son/daughter an opportunity to experience Post-16 A-Level courses at our Trust Schools' summer Taster Day on Tuesday 13th July 2021. We have been really pleased to join the family of schools in Endeavour Learning Trust this year and this is just one of the collaborations amongst the schools launched this term.

We are excited to be moving into this new phase in the development of our Post-16 provision, to deliver a bespoke, focused A-Level provision for likeminded students who value the family ethos we enjoy in our Trust schools.

This an exciting development for us that we hope will open up other possibilities in Post 16 thinking. If nothing else, we hope they will have a fabulous day and a further opportunity to consider subject options beyond their GCSEs.

LFD Testing: All students will be expected to carry out an LFT test on Sunday evening and register results with both the NHS and school.
