Science Summer School 2021

Amidst the challenges facing us all at present, we are delighted to share some positive news which will excite and inspire a selection of our Year 10 scientists who have demonstrated an interest in making a career in Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Maths (STEAM). Science Summer School is a national initiative co-founded by Professor Cox and Lord Andrew Mawson OBE, with the aim of inspiring young people to pursue careers in STEAM and become the next generation of Britain's scientists and engineers.

Professor Brian Cox CBE will be joining us virtually at West Lancashire College on **Tuesday 6th July 2021**, where he will host the first Science Summer School to take place in the North West and share his vision that "Britain is the best place to do science". This will be a blended event with both virtual and live elements.

Students will attend inspirational talks, including keynote presentations with Professor Cox and other guest speakers, and take part in a range of fabulous science and engineering activities all aimed at exciting their interest in the huge range of STEAM careers available to them.

For the duration of the event your child will remain in their year group bubble and will not interact with any other students outside of this. Students will follow social distancing guidelines and good hand hygiene practice will be observed. It is important that if your child is currently on medication for asthma etc. that they have this with them.

Time: 8:20 departure and 17:00 arrival back at school. Students will not be able to

use the normal school bus service and will need to arrange their own

also includes face masks which should be worn whilst travelling on the coach and indoors at the event with the exception of when eating and drinking.

current testing programme.



Educational Visits / Trips Terms and Conditions

Payments (if applicable)

All payments are non-refundable. If a student decides not to participate in a reserved visit / trip, cancellation will only be accepted in writing from the parent/carer. The Academy will endeavour to fill places that become available with a suitable replacement but this cannot be guaranteed. If there are insufficient numbers for a trip to go ahead then the trip will be cancelled.

Deposits collected for visits are done so according to the tour operator or booking agencies regulations and are therefore non-refundable in most cases. The terms and conditions of the Tour Operator or Agent will apply.

In the event of the trip being oversubscribed, we will allocate places on a "first come, first served" basis.

All visits based on particular curriculum subjects and necessary to follow the course are funded on a voluntary contributions basis. These contributions are required in order for trips to run. If you have financial difficulties please do not hesitate to contact the school to discuss further.

Any visit deemed to be a reward trip or not essential to following the curriculum has to be paid for in full.

<u>Behaviour</u>


