School Update

It has been a busy first term of 2023-2024 with many highlights and none more so than the day-to-day standards and learning that are evident in school. We have shared lots of updates in a range of ways, especially online. This term, our students have done us proud, driven by their kindness, respect and ambition. Some statistics of note:

- Approaching 35,000 award points across all year groups
- Nearly 800 visits to our library
- 38 Clubs have been on offer to our students at lunch time or after school just over 1000 participation points have been added to ClassCharts for students who have accessed clubs
- 39 Year 10 reading coaches have been trained
- 13 students have been awarded the E Pluribus Unum award for demonstrating our values
- Over 800 people and approaching 400 families visited us on Open Evening and 46 families have visited us during the school day

Congratulations to all of our students who have been nominated for and achieved Subject awards. The points have been added to ClassCharts in the last couple of days and this should be rightly celebrated.

We would like to say a big well done to Year 7. Their transition, maturity and the pride they take in all aspects of school life is exceptional and they truly are a credit to their primary school and you, their family.

Staffing

This week we are delighted to have welcomed Mrs Huyton back to school today in the English department and Mrs Ward (in RE) will follow early next term, returning from their respective periods of parental leave.

Mr Thornberry has secured a role in a safeguarding team outside of education and we wish him well as he moves onto pastures new. We are delighted to welcome Mrs Oliver to the role of Designated Safeguarding Lead alongside her role of Assistant Headteacher.

Uniform
