Lunch Arrangements – W/C 4 & 11 December Christmas Lunch – Thursday 21 December

As we look towards the end of term, we would like to give you some information about the final three weeks. Year 11 start their Practice Examinations on Monday 4 December for the last two weeks of term. We know that they have been working hard in class and at home to be prepared and we wish them the very best of luck. In order to administer the examinations, the structure of the school day will change and lunch will start one hour earlier at 12.10 - 12.50pm (3/2 split). Lunch ordering arrangements and the rota will remain unchanged and in the final week of term, on Monday 18 December, the times will revert to 'normal' (4/1 split).

We are also delighted to inform you that Burscough Priory Academy catering staff will be preparing Christmas lunch for our students on Thursday 21 December. The menu will include roast turkey and all the trimmings, a dessert and a drink at a cost of £3.20 per head.

If your child would like to join us for Christmas lunch, please make the payment on School Gateway, listed as 'Christmas Lunch 2023', by Tuesday 19 December at 4.00pm. Christmas lunch is a separate payment and cannot be deducted from a student's dinner money account.

If your *child is entitled to a free school meal* and would like a Christmas lunch, we will ensure that they receive this on the day. This needs to be ordered on School Gateway but there will be a zero charge for it. Please add the Christmas lunch to your basket and confirm your order and you will receive a confirmation pop-up message.

If you would like to request a vegetarian option or if your child has any other dietary requirements, please email enquiries@burscoughprioryacademy.org with the details. Sadly, the School Gateway system does not have the capacity for this to be recorded on it. The deadline for receipt of this information is Tuesday 19 December at 4.00pm.

If your child does not wish to have Christmas lunch, 'grab bags' will still be available and will be served in the ROSLA dining room. Food other than the Christmas lunch **must** be pre-ordered on the day using the screens in school.
