School Update

As we approach the final week of school for Year 11, we would like to give everyone some information about the plans and upcoming events. We are incredibly proud of their mature and diligent approach and we look forward to fully supporting them through their final weeks in school.

Year 10 Work Experience

Congratulations to all of our students who have been on Work Experience this week. The picture, feedback and testimony about them makes us gush with pride – if you do have anything you would like to share with us, please do! The students will return to school after the weekend on Tuesday, normal time in full school uniform and line up on the yard. On Tuesday they will be welcomed back with an assembly and this will also involve presentations by some of our local post-16 providers.

Lunch Arrangements

From Thursday 9 May until Monday 17 June, dates inclusive, we will move lunch to 12.10pm with a 3:2 split for lessons. On Tuesday 18 June, we will revert to our traditional 4:1 split. This is important information for our students and staff who manage health conditions and we encourage everyone to plan accordingly and make the adjustments that they need.

School Photograph
