- The skills for this question: CF, E, AQ, AC, WT, Z, ER

Question 4: Writer's viewpoint (opinion)

- Practise highlighting the key information in a mock question
- Practise annotating quotations in a mock question
- Revise attitude and tone words to show the writer's opinion
- Make sure you can identify a wide range of techniques e.g. hyperbole, anaphora etc. (check your notes from Y10)
- The skills for this question: CF, E, WT, AQ, WI, AC, Z
- **DO NOT refer to the reader in this question – it is about the writer's thoughts and feeling's**
