

# How can a Parent help?

- **Organisation** – school bag, equipment, Arbor, mobile phones, jewellery.
- **Travel** – bus, train, walk, run through the routine with them.
- **Punctuality/Attendance** – school starts at 8.45am with the line up.
- **Homework** – use Arbor to monitor how your child is doing and when they have homework.



# How can a Parent help?

- **Internet safety** – keep a close eye on their social media usage.
- **Lunches** – biometrics system, approx £2.90 per day, keep account topped up.
- **Activities** – lots of things to get involved in.
- **Lockers** – useful for keeping equipment/coats


