Remote Learning – Rotation 2

As the first rotation of the remote learning cycle comes to an end, we are pleased to be able to reflect on how successful the significant majority of our students have engaged when learning at home. We would like to take the opportunity to remind you of the plans for the weeks running up to the end of term.

As stated within our previous letter 'New Protocols After the Half-Term', maintaining our safe, calm environment in all areas of the schools throughout the day relies on high levels of staff supervision. With reduced numbers of staff in school, we moved to a rota system at the start of the half term, with a single year group out of school for a pre-planned week of remote learning. We will be continuing with this schedule, as published, until the end of the term on Friday 18th December.

Here are the details about the dates and which year group will be working remotely for the remaining weeks of this term:

Week Beginning	Year Group out of school	Return to school date
30 th November	Year 10	7 th December
7 th December	Year 9	14 th December
14 th December	Year 8	5 th January 2021

We have reiterated the plans and emphasised our high expectations of engagement this morning in assembly, before the week of remote learning begins. Today and tomorrow, we will be contacting the parents of vulnerable children and those of critical workers who attended school during the first rotation and we will offer supervised remote learning in school.

Any students in receipt of free school meals that are working from home will receive a voucher during the week they are working from home. This will be posted out to your home address.

Should there be the need to widen restrictions, this will be implemented in a phased manner, with as much notice given to you as circumstances allow. As always, we continue to monitor the national and local picture and follow advice from Lancashire County Council and Department for Education.

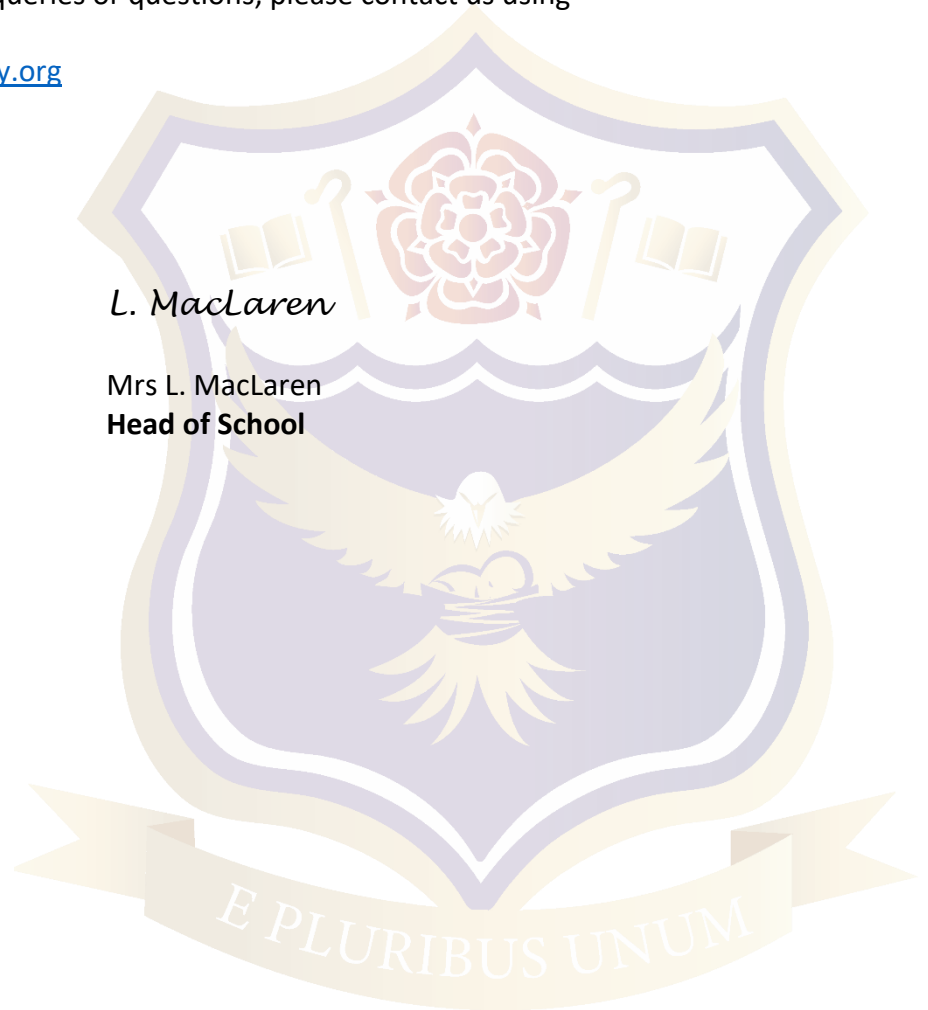
