



# Ventilation

"As much as possible, fresh air is increased within buildings by opening windows and doors frequently to encourage ventilation, taking account of any potential security or fire safety issues."

# Hygiene







- Parents can access information on their child via an online platform called ClassCharts






# Meaningful homework in order to reinforce learning and promote independence which is:

- Purposeful and meaningful
- Includes a wide range of activities reading, preparation and consolidation; knowledge and skills based
- Reading, Revision or Recall
- Set on ClassCharts



#### How can I help my child with their learning?

- Ask them about their day (and their learning!)
- Check work set on ClassCharts
- Encourage work to be done in an area without distractions if possible, or to attend homework club
- Encourage them to try to retrieve information and test themselves

Engaging fiction and non-fiction prose introduces words in context, encouraging reading and increasing cultural capital






