Free DfE 30 minute Breakfast Club

Burscough Village Primary School will be one of the 750 school nationwide rolling out the DfE Free Breakfast Scheme for all children.

We're working closely with the local authority to put plans in place, ensuring a smooth

launch. This initiative will give every child the opportunity to start their day with a healthy breakfast, socialise with their friends and help them feel energised, focused and ready to learn. With two new summer incentives, we hope to see an improvement with the congestion on the roads at school pick up and drop off times. In addition, we are working closely with the council and local authority to explore further options for improving traffic flow and parking in the area.

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2 Year Old Nursery Places

We're planning to expand our Nursery to offer more places for 2-year-olds. With DfE funding (pending confirmation), we hope to expand our modular nursery building, specially designed for younger children. This new space will give local families more access to high-quality early education in a safe and nurturing environment. Our aim is to give every child the best possible start, helping them learn, grow, and thrive. We're excited about this opportunity to support more families in our community.
