Dear Parents and Carers,

I can't believe we are already making decisions about next year. This year has flown by!

A huge warm welcome to our new reception and nursery parents. Thank you for attending the reception welcome meeting on Wednesday evening. I hope that you have some information to get you started with your child's learning journey at Burscough Village.

We are very excited to tell you that we have appointed two new teachers for September. Miss Waring-Collins who is an experienced Year 6 teacher with a performing arts background. We think she will love teaching our current year 5's next year. Miss Lawrence has just completed her teacher training with flying colours and is excited to be teaching our current year 4 children in September. She will be coming in to meet the class and join in school activities during the summer term. We look forward to them joining the Burscough Village family.

After the holidays, we will start our transition sessions. Our new Reception children will start them on **Friday 7th June** with a drop-in session for the parents and children. Then, every Friday afterwards until Friday 5th July, the children will move up to their new classes with their new teachers.

In September 2024, the class teachers will be as follows:

On Friday 28th June we would like to invite the nursery children, who are staying in nursery for another year and don't usually attend the setting on a Friday, to join us for the transition day and get the opportunity to meet Mrs Prytherch.

I will confirm the teaching assistant's roles after the holidays. We still have some aspects to confirm with the school budget and we are awaiting some EHCP's as well.

The majority of the year 6 pupils will go on their transition days to Burscough Priory on Thursday 27th June and Friday 28th June. For the other transition sessions in school, they will work with Mrs Logie to complete the year 6 curriculum.

Transition Afternoons

All children will move classes at 1.30pm with all their belongings to go home. We ask you to pick your child up from their new classroom. This will give you an opportunity to meet the staff, ask any questions and start to build relationships with the staff for September. If you would like to meet the teacher to discuss your child's needs further, please arrange a meeting with the teacher.

New Reception children 2023- If your child already attends our nursery, the children will be taken to the Reception classroom for their induction sessions.

For those children who have additional needs, we have already begun to handover information and discuss the needs of the children. ISP's and EHC plans are being discussed and shared. The staff are attending appointments or sessions with speech and language, OT and other professionals. Where needed, the teachers will arrange a meeting to discuss a smooth transition for your child.

The Nursery, Year 1 – Year 4 'Meet the teacher' meetings will take place on **Wednesday 5**th **June**. We will have two sessions one at 3.30pm and one at 5.00pm - please book via School Comms. **Year 5 and 6** meetings will take place on **Friday 28**th **June at 3pm and 5:00pm**.

You will receive a transition questionnaire for your child to take with them to their new class on Friday 14th June 2024.

SEN appointments - Mrs Beevers SENCO - Monday 10th June

We are seeing a significant increase in parents wishing to meet with Mrs Beevers regarding Special Education Needs. Unfortunately, there is only one Mrs Beevers and she does have teaching responsibilities as well. To try to accommodate parents and manage Mrs Beevers workload, she will be available on Monday 10th June 3:00pm – 6:00pm. An appointment can be made if you have any specific SEN questions, or you would like to discuss your child's next steps and development. This will be your opportunity to meet with Mrs Beevers in the summer term, no further dates will be available until Autumn term. Mrs Beevers will aim to get back to all parents and carers but there is starting to be a little wait to fit it all in.
