School Improvement Areas

- Geography and Computing have been designated as key curriculum subjects for this academic year.

Safety & Security

Keeping everyone safe at school is our top priority. The governors carried out a full review of school security, following guidance from Lancashire County Council. They have approved the measures we have in place. Areas reviewed included:

- CCTV
- Fences
- Lighting
- Security and alarms outside of school hours
- Building projects and repairs
