### **Home/school communication**

#### **Toileting**

We understand that all children may have the odd accident and some children will still be learning how to use the toilet correctly. Please send in spare clothes for your child and return any nursery spare clothes your child may have to borrow.

### **Clothing, Bags and Wellies**

Please bring a filled water bottle to nursery each day. They will be returned home each night to be cleaned. Please label all clothing, coats, and shoes. We learn outside in all weathers and have opportunities for messy play, so please bring a bag or backpack with spare clothes. We will keep this bag in nursery until we use the spare clothes and will hand back for you to wash and add new spare clothes. Please label spare clothes. We cannot hand your child's bag back to you daily. Please bring a labelled pair of wellies that will be kept in nursery until the end of the term. If you can supply a mud suit for your child that would be appreciated, if not we have some spare suits. Please remember we will learn outside in all weathers and ask for your child to have an appropriate coat. Your child will not need to bring any other equipment into school, as nursery will provide them with everything they need.

# **Snack**

We offer a rolling snack which is available throughout the morning and afternoon sessions. Money for snack is taken via parent pay. Milk is offered for free. Water is always available.

#### **Key Person**

Your child now has a 'Key Person' in school. This is to help develop a close relationship with an adult in school. This person will offer comfort and support to your child and get to know individual personalities and sensitivities to understand their needs a little better. However, we are all here to work as a team to support all the children in the class.

We have enjoyed getting to know all the new children on their visits and time at our school. I look forward to the year ahead and working together to help the children flourish and grow.
