Important Information for Year 5

PE Days

Year 5 children will have PE on Tuesday morning and Thursday afternoon.

Children should bring their full PE kit and trainers (please see school website for details) at the start of term and leave it in their locker until the end of the half-term.

If at any point PE kits need to go home for cleaning/after-school PE club etc., please ensure that they return to school the next day.

Homework

Year 5 pupils will receive the following homework to support and enhance their learning:

<u>Maths and English</u> - Children will be receiving Maths and English homework each week.

Homework will be given out on a **Tuesday** and it will need to be completed and handed in the following **Monday**. Children need to make sure that they look after their homework in the plastic wallet provided to them.

<u>Spellings</u> – Every <u>Tuesday</u> children will receive 10 spellings which they will have to learn ready for a test the following <u>Monday</u>. A paper copy of the spellings will be given to pupils to enable them to practice at home. Alongside this, pupils will work on these spellings during lessons.

<u>Reading</u> – Pupils should try to read as frequently as possible. Whilst pupils will be reading independently, we still ask that they or yourselves record when they have read in their reading records, so we can keep track of how much they are doing at home. I will be checking this each **Friday**.

Guitars

Year 5 will have whole class guitar lessons every Wednesday afternoon for the first term (up until Christmas). Please ensure they bring their allocated guitar to school each Wednesday, as they will be taking them home again at the end of the day. It is important that the children take responsibility for caring for their guitars at home to keep them in good condition.

I know your children are ready for the next step in their education and I am really excited to get to know them over the next year and for us to work as a team in supporting your children.
