Thank you for your interest in joining our team as a **Specialist SEND HLTA**.

We are delighted that we will be developing a new provision within our school to support pupils with **cognition and learning needs**, primarily within Key Stage 2. This provision is being designed to ensure that pupils who are working at a different rate are able to access a curriculum that meets their needs, builds confidence and secures strong foundations for future learning.

At the heart of this role is the opportunity to help establish a **calm, purposeful learning environment** where pupils can thrive. Each morning, you will work with small groups of children, supporting learning through a **creative, engaging curriculum built around English, Maths and PSHE**, using **topics, real-life experiences and children's interests** to bring learning to life. Pupils will then re-join their classes in the afternoon to maintain a strong sense of belonging and inclusion.

We will be working with specialists to **design a curriculum that is carefully matched to the needs of our pupils**, ensuring learning is meaningful, accessible and ambitious.

This will include:

- Teaching key English and Maths skills through **practical, hands-on and purposeful activities**
- Using **themes and topics** to create meaningful links across learning
- Supporting pupils to develop confidence, independence and understanding through **PSHE and real-life contexts**

This provision is distinct from our SEMH nurture offer and has a clear focus on **supporting learning needs through high-quality teaching, curriculum adaptation and strong relationships**.

What We Are Looking For


We are seeking someone who:
