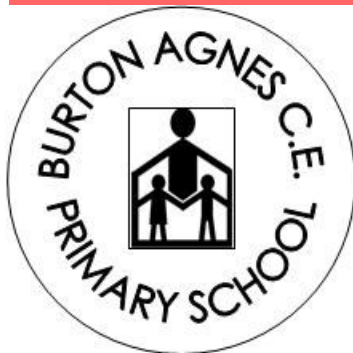

## Special Mentions

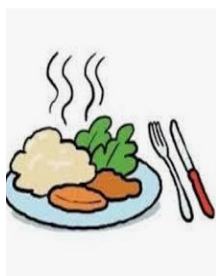
