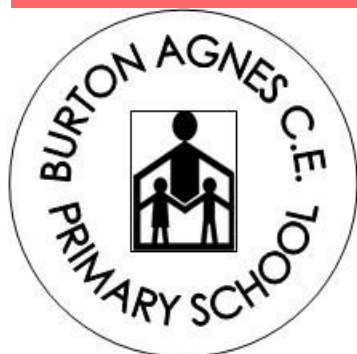

## Covid Reminder

With cases on the increase again it is important for us to remind ourselves of the procedures if your child has covid symptoms.

If your child has a positive covid test or displays covid symptoms they should stay at home and avoid contact with other people until three days after they took the test. After this period the child may return to school UNLESS they still have a high temperature or still feel unwell. They should stay at home until their temperature returns to normal.

For adults the isolation period is 5 days. Please can you inform school if your child has covid or anyone in the family has covid. Thank you.
