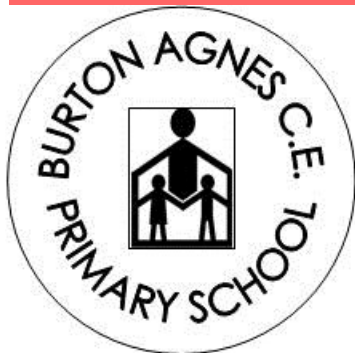

Staff from Tesco in Driffield visited Class 4 to cast their experienced eye over the tantalising selection of chocolate boxes designed by the pupils. Children had to come up with their own array of sweets, using a list of suggested fillings. They created their own packing and marketing strategies and invented catchy names for their products and their companies. Using a costing sheet, they also had to work out how much their chocolates would cost to make and how much profit they could earn.



This was an enterprise project designed to develop teamwork, problem solving, creativity, maths skills, data handling and an interest in the world of work. Everyone produced and pitched their products to a very high standard.

The judges decided that Finn, Taylor and Jamie had the best product of all.
