If you are bringing little ones, please can we ask that they stay away from the track to avoid accidents.

Sun protection

- Send your child to school with a sun hat. A baseball type cap with a peak and fabric to keep the sun off the back of the neck are ideal. Please make sure it is named.
- Please apply 8 hour sun cream **before** your child comes to school. This is the best approach.
- Staff are not allowed to apply sun cream, so your child will need to be able to do this themselves. If you are not applying at home, the sun cream needs to be in a named bottle.
- Send in fresh water, every day in a named bottle.
