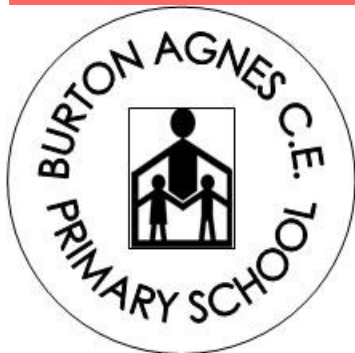

If someone in your house displays symptoms or has been in close contact with someone who has tested positive you must self isolate and I would urge you to get a test.

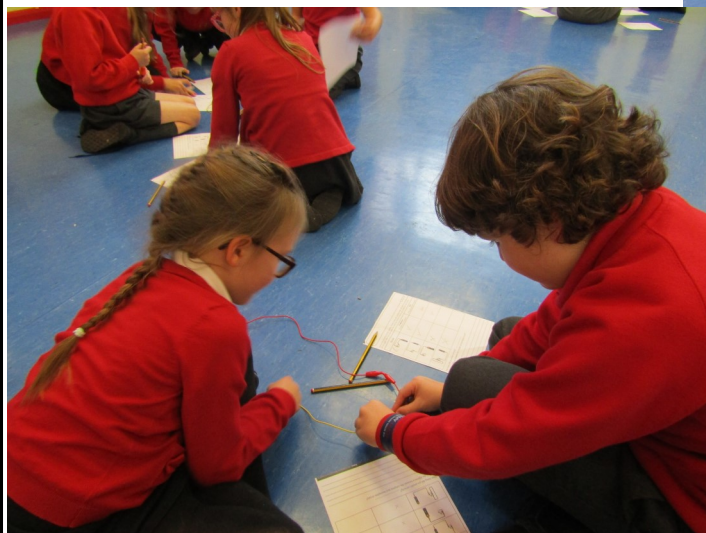
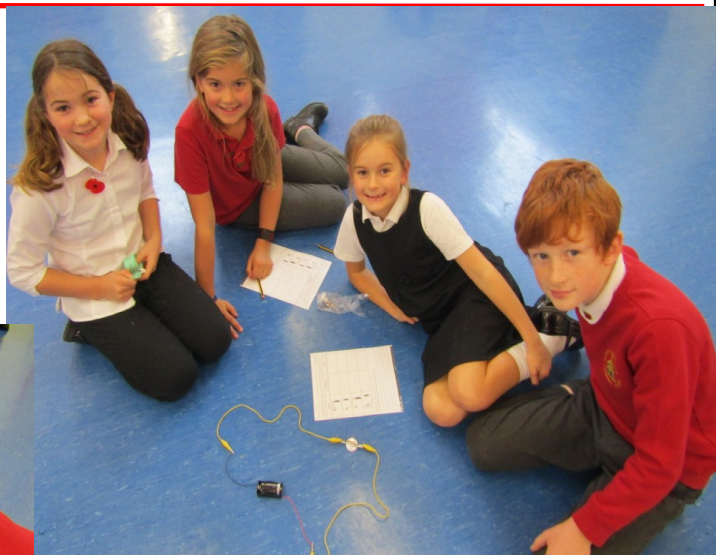
