Home time—the gates will open at 3.15 pm. Children will be brought on to the yard by their class teacher at **3.20pm.** Your child's class teacher will not release them to you until they have seen you.

The change to normal school times will mean that there is more traffic around school at the end of the day. Please take care with where you park. The zig zags are not for parking on, or dropping off, or collecting children on. They are there for the safety of our children. We will no longer be using the one way system and entrance and exit will be via the gate that you currently leave out of. This is the safest route due to the pedestrian barriers.


As always we require you to contact school if someone different is picking your child up.

New payment system in school

We are pleased to inform you that from Monday 28th March you will be able to pay for your school meals online. We will be proving this service through Eduspot School Money, the same company that we use to deliver text messages and emails to you.



As soon as we go live you will receive a text message/email in-

viting you to download the free app to your phone and set up your details to allow you to pay online. There will also be an option to pay for meals on a computer/tablet rather than a phone. The system is very user friendly but we have also attached a parent's guide should you have any difficulties. This can also be found on the school website in the school dinners section.

If you do not wish to pay for your school meals online, you are still able to send your payment in to the school office in a named envelope as you have done before.

In time we will be looking to set up all our payments this way. We hope that this system will be a more convenient option to you as parents.
