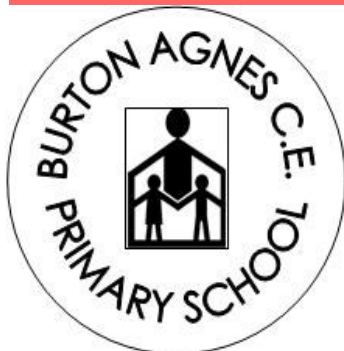

A Note From Mrs Jameson

At Burton Agnes we are proud of our values of friendship, care and trust and how, along with other Christian values, they help to shape school life. In the first half of the spring term, we have been focusing on the value of courage, encouraging the children to consider how developing and living out this value can help them on a personal level, in their relationships with others and in their learning. In our whole school collective worships this term, we have been exploring this value in more depth, giving the children the opportunity to reflect on courage, fears, stepping out of their comfort zone and having the confidence to do what they believe is the right thing. We are learning about our inspirational people from the Bible and from the past and present who inspire us and give us the encouragement we need to believe that we can face our fears and fulfil our own goals and aspirations and make a positive difference to ourselves and others. The children have also been able to share their own thoughts about courage and we have given advice to others to help them overcome challenges.

Coupled with this, our work in PSHE this term is all about developing coping skills and how we can develop our resilience. Please take the time to chat to your children about this at home.

Class 4 Visit to York Mosque and the Robert Fuller Gallery

Class 4 have been learning about Islam in their RE lessons and thoroughly enjoyed the opportunity to visit the Mosque in York this week. The children were able to look round the Mosque and further their understanding of the Islamic Faith. The children were able to ask questions and speak to members of the Islamic faith to find out more about life as a Muslim. They were able to make accurate comparisons between the life of a Muslim and the life of a Christian. Class 4 were exceptionally respectful whilst visiting a place of worship and showed great behaviour throughout the trip, making all the adults very proud!

After visiting the Mosque we took the opportunity to visit the Robert Fuller Gallery at Thixendale. Robert Fuller is the local artist that we have been inspired by to help us with our art skills last term. The children were given the opportunity to look at Robert's work, look at live cameras showing animals in the wild and then show off their art skills by doing some sketching of their own.
