Class 3 - Please send your child in to school with **1 hard boiled egg on Friday 22nd March**

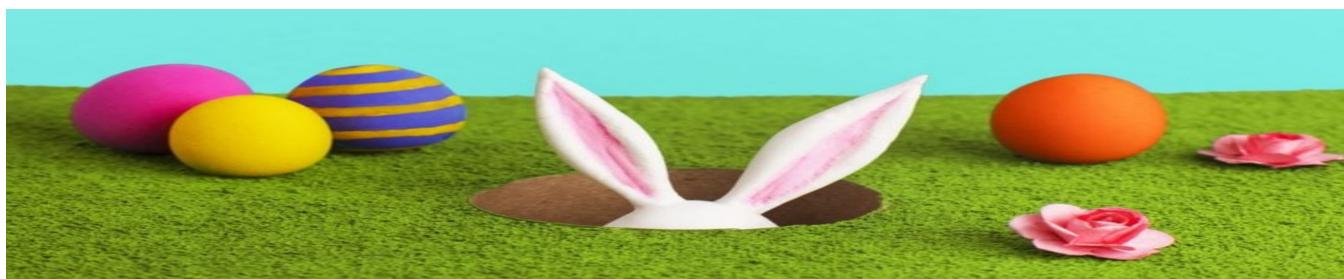
Class 3 only need 1 egg as they are making Easter cards

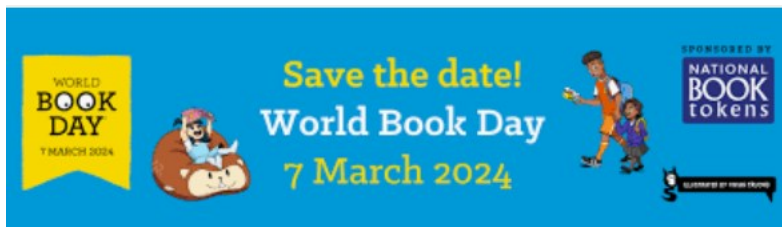
