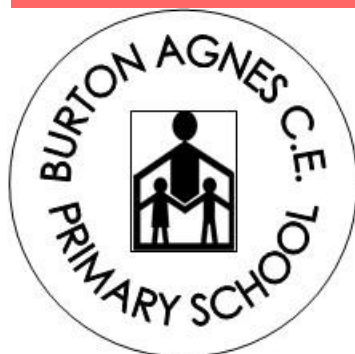

I hope today's newsletter finds everyone in our Burton Agnes families happy, healthy and refreshed after the half term break.

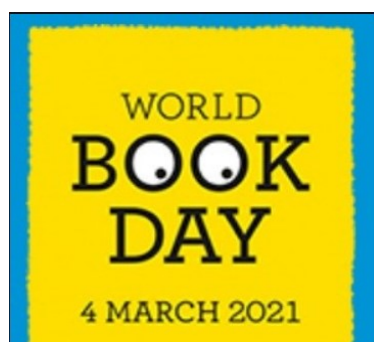
It is with great excitement that I write today's newsletter. I am sure we were all delighted with the government's announcement that
