


A Note from Mrs Jameson

Its been another busy week this week with lots of enrichment activities taking place, both in and out of school, to strengthen our curriculum offer.

This week we have been visited by Dave Rockett, who is a science, technology, engineering and maths (STEM) Ambassador for Northern Gas Networks. Mr Rockett is super enthusiastic about delivering fun and engaging sessions about Net Zero and helping to spread awareness about the challenges we face, and possible solutions.

Class 4 learnt all about cleaner fuel for cars. Firstly they learnt about how green hydrogen can be produced (electrolysis). They then got the opportunity to work with model cars that are powered using hydrogen in a fuel cell and carried out an investigation to see what affects the running time of the hydrogen cars.



The children in Class 3 were challenged to the max by answering questions about net zero, climate change and future energy. Each time they got an answer right they were given a code which unlocked padlocks on a box they were given. Once all of the padlocks were unlocked there was a surprise inside the box. The children demonstrated knowledge about the subject, team work and perseverance.





The children in Class 1 and 2 learnt all about greenhouse gases, what they are and how they form and linked this to the theme of superheroes by creating characters to promote clean air and destroy the greenhouse gases.
