It has been lovely to see after school sports clubs back in full swing this week with an increased number of children taking part. The government provides schools with a sum of money each year to be spent on providing the children with access to additional sporting opportunities beyond the National Curriculum requirements to engage more children in sport and adopt healthier lifestyles. Some of our money is spent on providing the after school clubs, free of charge, to our pupils. Each half term we try to change the focus of the activity to allow it to appeal to all children in the school. Many children have had a taste of a variety of sporting activities including boxercise, gymnastics, hockey, tennis etc. with many children going on to do these activities outside of school too.



This week the children also had a taster session of 'Wild', an activity provided by First Step Sports. This saw the children taking part in outdoor and adventurous activities that tested their resilience and encouraged team work and problem solving skills in the great outdoors. The children were tasked with putting up a tent in a fun way.

The children loved it and many asked if we could have more sessions like this in school.



Continuing with our sporting theme, our PE funding also pays for the after school competitions that the children can take part in. This week the children in KS2 had the opportunity to take part in an Orienteering Festival at Driffeld School. All of our children were exceptional in their performances. Ted and Henry came 2nd in their age group with Sophie and Cam coming first place in their age groups. The children said they enjoyed the activity which mixed map reading and running skills together.
