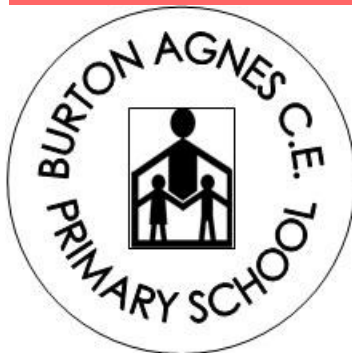


Faith Leaders visit Burton Agnes

Holiday activities

Each child and young person in receipt of benefits related free school meals is entitled to 4 funded places on any HAF programme in the Christmas holidays for free (subject to availability). There are over 20 HAF delivery partners organising fun activities from sports camps to forest schools, dance workshops to craft sessions across the East Riding, with sessions lasting at least 4 hours and a meal is provided for each participant too. All of our programmes are inclusive, but we also offer specific programmes for children and young people with SEND. Below are some flyers of all the programmes that are taking place across the county to ensure families know about the programmes on offer. There is also a limited number of HAF places available to children and young people who have an Education, Health and Care plan too regardless of their financial situation.
