Year 11 – ‘All about you’ conference

Friday 23rd April 2021

This year we are holding a year 11 employability conference to help provide our students with opportunities to try hands on career sector activities as well as develop their employability skills. This conference is funded primarily through Aspire to HE and as part of this funding they are required to keep records of students who attend (see [Information for families](#) sent out before Christmas)

The conference, originally planned for 22nd January, but rescheduled due to Government Guidelines to 23rd April will include a 1.5hr workshop in an occupational sector of choice, a mock interview with feedback, a motivational speaker, a workplace tour, National Citizenship Service support as well as training sessions in communication, leadership, teamwork, study skills and raising aspirations.
