Start is accessible anytime on computers and compatible mobile and tablet devices and is designed to enable young people to make excellent choices about their futures.

Start allows young people to:

- Find jobs that match their skills, qualities, interests and work preferences
- Understand what different careers are like, including earning potential and the qualifications required
- Search live local Apprenticeship opportunities matched to their areas of interest
- Understand Labour Market Information by seeing which businesses are recruiting in your are. This helps to identify realistic local employment demand when making decisions about careers.

Students and families can register for a free account on START. Instructions on how to register and use some of the features are shown below.






Go to the website <a href="https://www.startprofile.com/">https://www.startprofile.com/</a> and click on register.







Input your personal details and then click get started. You will then be prompted to log in.




If you are a student, click the first option, if you are a parent or carer, click the third option.

In your profile section you will find career related activities. You can also add more details about you and search for career sectors that interest you.




Also, in your profile section you have a locker to store documents. This can be things like exam certificates, CV's, work experience records, photographs, achievements, references etc.
