Burton Borough has a strong belief around good quality work experience. All our year 10 students take part in a two-week work placement at the end of the Summer Term. However, with current COVID restrictions, it is unlikely that face to face placements will take place this year. The safety of our students, families, staff and placement providers must be our main focus.



We do how that once the pandemic is over, we will be able to go back to facilitating the twoweek programme. When it does return, we will be working closely, once again with the Educational Business Links team at Telford & Wrekin, to ensure all our placements are health and safety checked prior to confirmation.

Our year 10 students will still study all the work-related learning in PSHE lessons and we will be constantly letting families know of virtual placements as they become available.
