BBS Pre-Transition Day Programme Science & Craft Session – Monday 10th June 2024

Dear Soon-to-be Year 7 BBS Students,

We are looking forward to welcoming you to our second 'Science & Craft' after school session on Monday 10th June. <u>Please read the following plan for this session:</u>

- Please arrive on site from 3.45pm. Please note there will be <u>limited</u> parking spaces available on school site. We kindly ask that you take the opportunity to walk onto school grounds where possible.
- Our Year 7 team will be on hand to greet you outside at the double doors next to reception. Hopefully you will remember your tutor group allocation from our previous session but if you do not, or if you are joining us for the first time, please show our team your tutor allocation letter, or let them know you are unsure of your tutor group, we will then double check which group you belong to and then you will then be invited into our New Hall.
- Once you are in the New Hall, you will sit down with your tutor group for a five-minute introduction from Mrs Heins. Following the introduction, four tutor groups will then be escorted to take part in a science session whilst the remaining four tutor groups will take part in a craft session in the canteen. Halfway through the session, the tutor groups in science will changeover with the tutor groups doing craft. PLEASE bring your school pencil case to this session, this will help to supplement supplies provided.
- At the end of the session (5pm), the science session groups will be escorted group by group into the New Hall to join the craft session tutor groups, where you can then reunite with your parents/carers. For children with alternative arrangements, you will be asked to wait with Miss Hicks before leaving. We kindly ask parents/carers to arrive at the side doors next to reception where your child can then be collected.
