Votes for Schools

This year we are introducing **Votes for Schools** into tutor time **once a week**.

Every week, **Votes for Schools** ask young people around the UK to share their thoughts on a key issue based on the discussions they have had during tutor time.

We discuss these topics before we vote and then students decide on their point of view from the information they have been given. These topics range from **climate change** to the **cost of living**, **AI to anti-racism**, all the topics are about things that are currently in the news.

Each week we will send the topic and some information about it, home to parents so you can **continue the conversation** with your children.




Goal Setting linked to Recognition

We feel that **goal setting** is an important **skill to learn**. Goal setting **motivates** and **focusses your mind** ensuring that you don't get distracted from what is **important**. Goals provide a sense of **purpose** and meaning and help students to develop their **personal growth**, this increases **confidence** and **self-esteem**.

To this end, each week we have a focus in goal setting from one of our **character virtues**. Students all have goal setting books and set themselves a goal or goals that are linked to the **focus of the week**.

Each week students also can **revisit** the previous week's goal and make a note of how they **achieved** it or if they still must work on it.

This gives **all** students the opportunity to **reflect** and set their **shortterm vision** for the week that follows, allowing them to be ambitious. They also set long-term goals and must develop the resilience to overcome obstacles to achieve them.



Communication

Here at BBS, we recognise that **communication** with our **students**, **parents** and **carers** is important.

Frequently Asked Questions



What if my child forgets their PE kit?

Head of Year/Assistant Head of Year will ring parents/carers to bring in. Alternatively, we may be able to lend PE uniform.

What if my child does not have money on their Scopay account?

We would never let a child go hungry. We would provide a basic meal that would go on to their account and then parents/carers would be asked to reimburse the school.

What if my child forgets their drink/water bottle?

We would provide a cup to use the water fountains on site.

What if my child forgets an item of uniform?

Parents/carers would be contacted to bring in the item of clothing e.g. Shoes. Alternatively, the student can exchange their phone/earbuds for uniform at the uniform shop and collect at the end of the school day.

What if my child forgets their timetable?

Students can ask their tutors to print off their timetable should they misplace it.



Frequently Asked Questions



What if my child feels poorly?

The pastoral team will be on hand throughout the day to refer students to first aid. Depending on the nature of the call, first aid my ring you i.e. head injuries.

What if my child is ill?

If your child is poorly, please ring our school absence line by 8.30am to notify the attendance team.

What if my child misses the bus?

If it is because the student was late, they will get a late mark.

What if my child is late to school because the bus is late?

In this instance, they would not get a late mark as this is out of their control.

What if my child has an appt in the school day?

Only emergency dental and doctor, or orthodontist/ hospital should be arranged during the school day. Please email your child's form tutor and our attendance team with proof of appointment.
