Goal Setting

Rewards at BBS



At BBS, we have identified **6-character virtues** linked to our values of being **AMBITIOUS**, **PROUD** and **CARING**. We believe these are essential to the future success of our students. The character virtues decided on by our school community are **Resilience**, **Motivated**, Leadership, Respectful, Teamwork and Kindness.

RECOGNITION POINTS

Students receive recognition points in the last 5 minutes of every lesson for displaying these virtues. We know that if we praise what we want students to repeat then this will become habitual, creating successful and inspiring young citizens.

WEEKLY

Students will be reflecting on their character virtues and setting goals in form time. Year group teams will be celebrating successes in assemblies. Parents will be able to see the virtues awarded to their child on MCAS.

TERMLY & END OF YEAR

Students will be rewarded in assemblies with certificates and prizes, End of Year celebration. Students have been voting on what they would like to be rewarded with.
