Ex student makes a return to BBS.

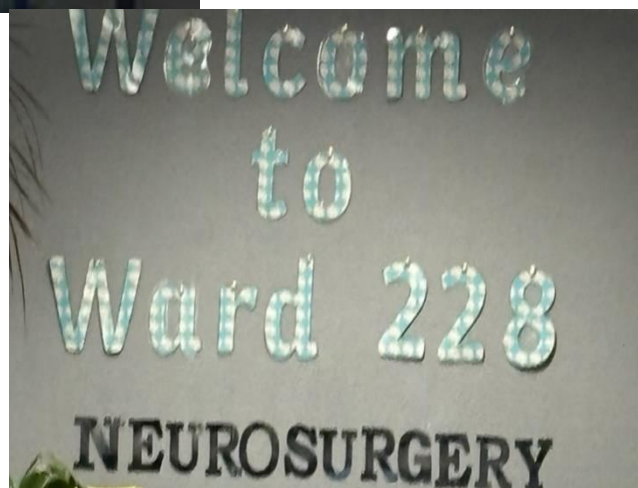

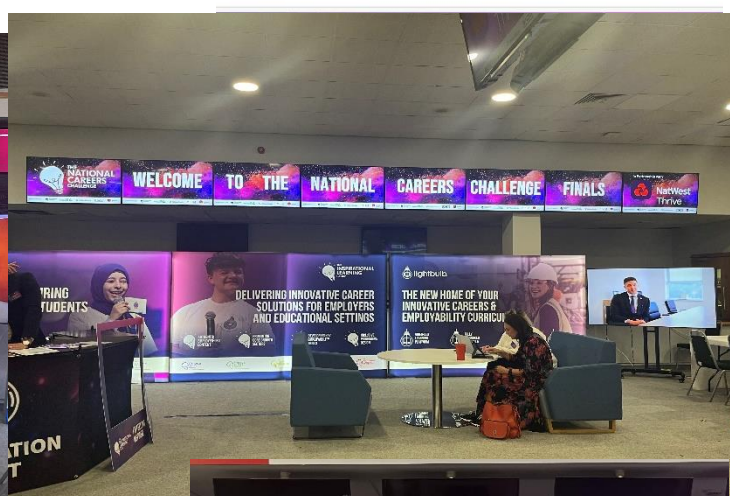
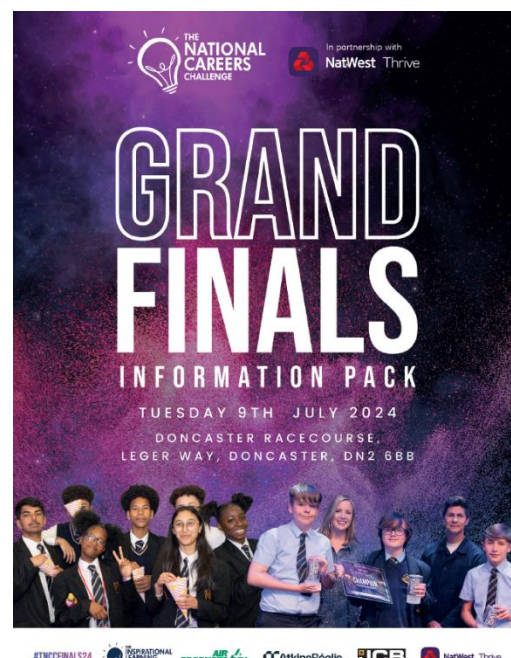
The National Careers Challenge 2024

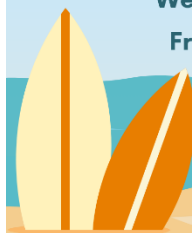
